TE KAHUI TAMARIKI MĀORI ENRICHMENT CLASS

This is a special class in which all subjects of the New Zealand Curriculum are taught using English and a portion of the timetable is dedicated to the learning of Te Reo Māori. Students are also involved in tikanga Māori programmes.

Whanau may choose to have their children enrolled in this unit but it is essential that both the parents and the child are committed to the aims and aspirations of this special class and are prepared to support and work to achieving them.

If applications exceed available places in the class, a selection procedure may be necessary.

The class programme aims to:

- Teach Te Reo and tikanga Māori – provide a whanau environment for learning
- Improve performance and achievement in all curriculum areas
- Involve the whanau in student learning
- Meet with whanau and akonga at least twice a year for Learning Conferences.

Choosing to be part of Te Kahui Tamariki means that the student's whanau desires and accepts the aims of the programme and will be actively supportive.
