All subjects of our New Zealand Curriculum are taught in English and in Māori for our more fluent speakers from kura kaupapa and other whānau classes. A portion of the timetable is dedicated to the learning of Te Reo Māori and Te Ao Māori. **Kapa Haka is a compulsory component of the programme**.

Whānau will need to submit this application form if they wish to choose this option for their children. It is essential that both the parents / caregivers and the child are committed to the aims and aspirations of Te Kāhui Tamariki Bilingual Class and are prepared to support and work to achieve them.

If applications exceed available places in the class, a selection procedure may be necessary and unsuccessful applicants will be placed onto a waiting list.

- teach and / or extend our students in Te Reo Māori, Tīkanga and Te Ao Māori
- improve performance and achievement for Māori in all curriculum areas
- work in partnership with whānau to support their child's learning and progress through regular hui and learning conferences
- promote and be ambassadors of our school values that are inherent of Te Kāhui Tamariki;
   Kaitiakitanga, Manaakitanga, Whanaungatanga me Rangatiratanga
